Dissertation and Innocence Project

Learners complete either the Dissertation or Innocence Project as a mandatory module in Stage 3 of the LL.B. (Hons) in Criminal Justice.

- Selection for the Innocence Project is by way of application and appointment by the Board of the Innocence Project.
- Selection for the Dissertation module is by way of submission of a Research Proposal. Research topic must relate to an area of Criminal Law.

Learners in Stage 2 and Stage 3 will choose electives from the list below in Stage and Stage 3 to complete a total of 60 credits during each year.
